Ninth Circuit Will Video Stream Case to Federal Courthouse in Honolulu

SAN FRANCISCO – Oral arguments before the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the case of *Honolulutraffic.com v. FTA*, which are scheduled for Thursday, August 15, 2013, in San Francisco, may be watched at the federal courthouse in Honolulu, Hawaii, via live video streaming. The case will be heard at 2 p.m. Pacific Time, 11 a.m. Hawaii Time.

Citizens in the Honolulu area can observe the proceedings in the Aha Nonoi courtroom on the fourth floor of the Prince Jonah Kūhiō Kalanianaʻole U.S. Courthouse and Federal Building, 300 Ala Moana Blvd., Honolulu.

Honolulutraffic.com v. FTA, Case 13-15277, involves a challenge to the adequacy of environmental review for a major transit project. The case will be heard by a three-judge panel consisting of Circuit Judges Stephen Reinhardt of Los Angeles and Andrew D. Hurwitz of Phoenix, Arizona, and Senior Circuit Judge Mary M. Schroeder, also of Phoenix.
